Ko au eni 'Eiki, fai mai Ha'ō fekau.

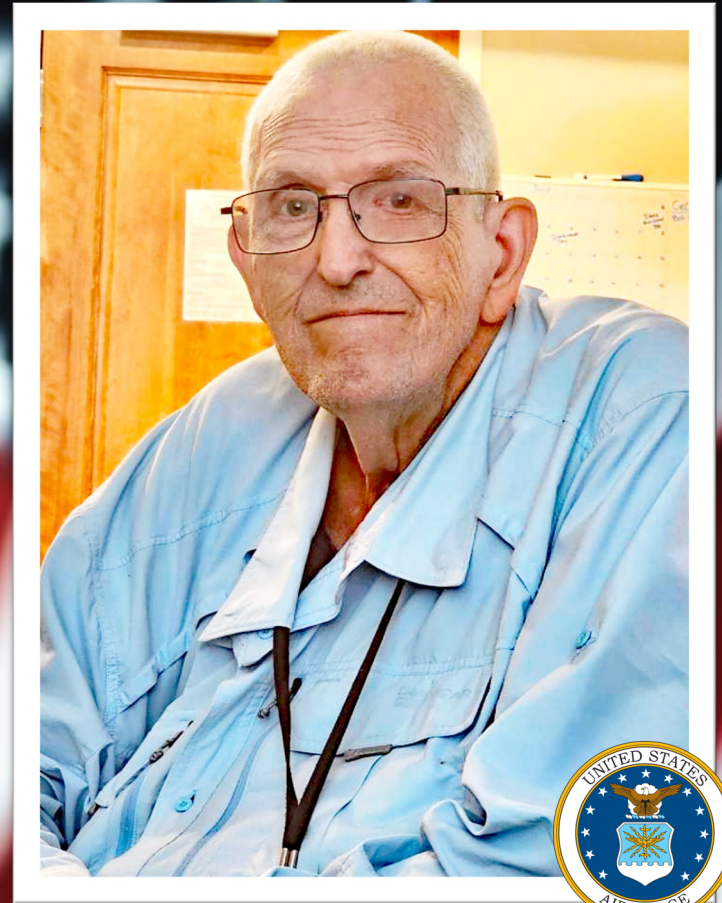
I Will Raise My Voice (English)
