Let your sorrow last for just a while.

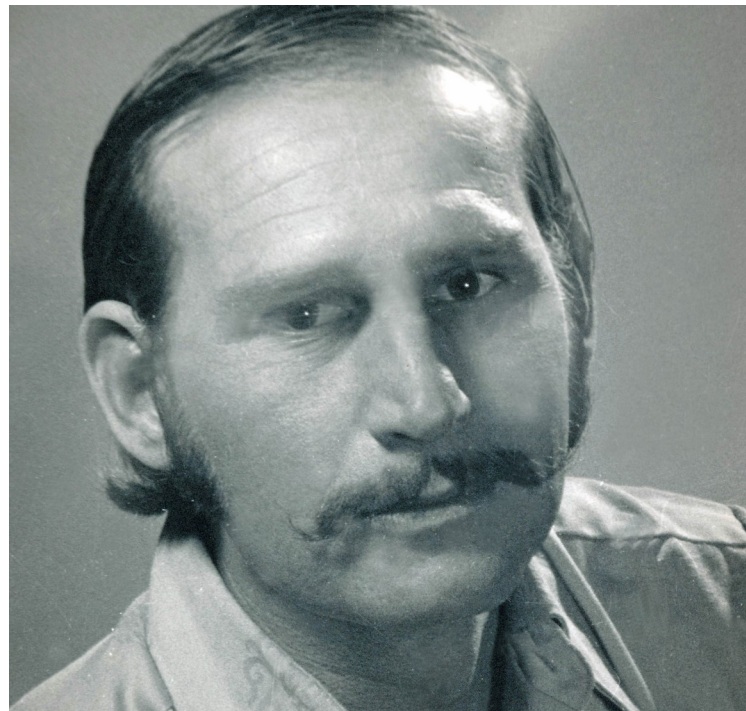
Comfort each other and try to smile.
