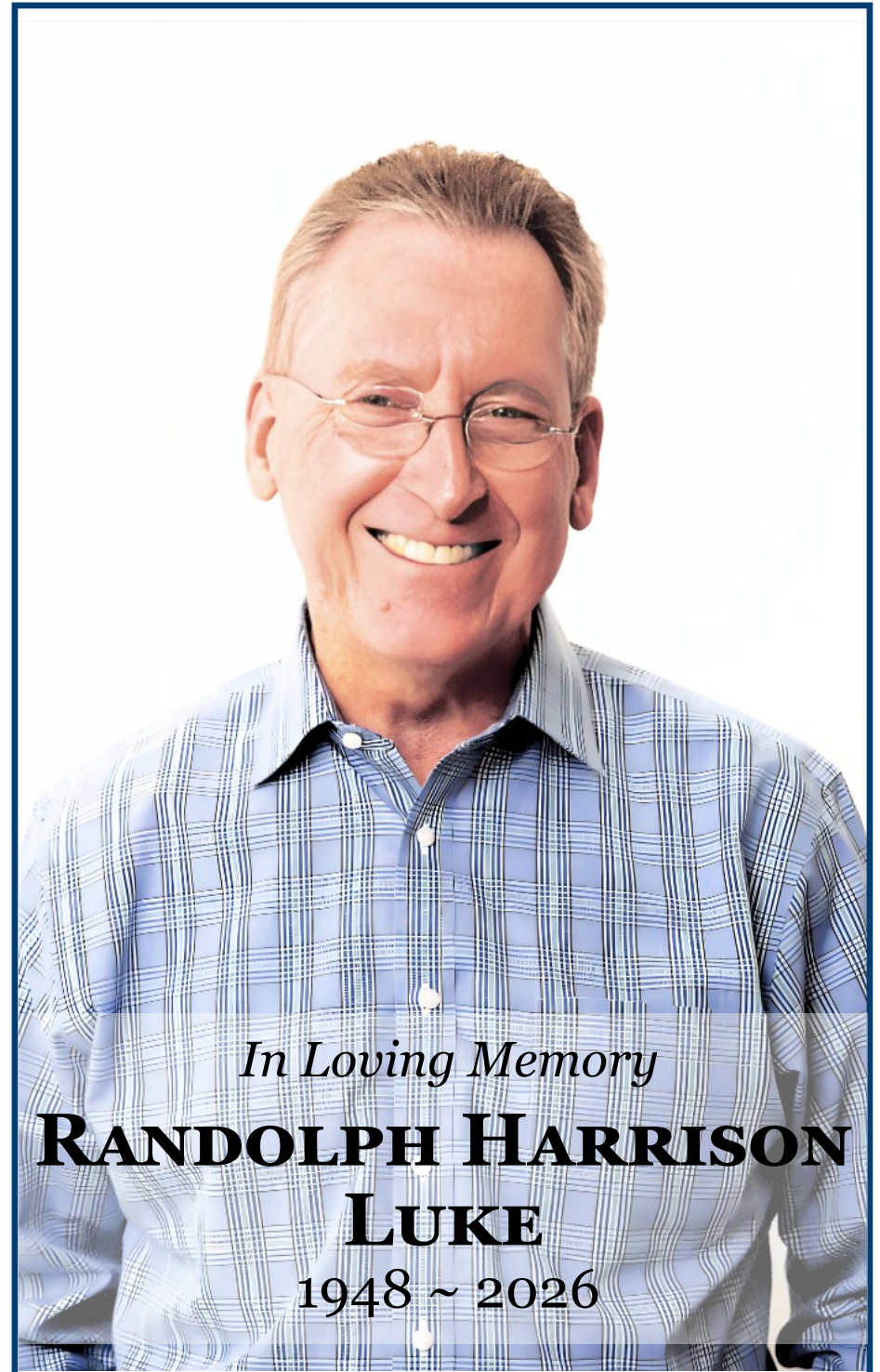


We are grateful for every memory
