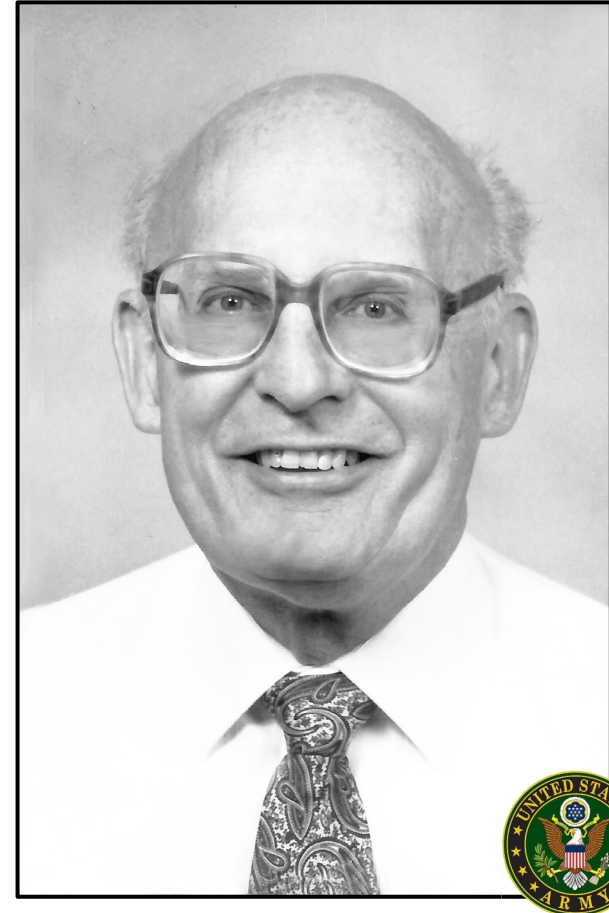


## WHAT MAKES A DAD
