Do not stand at my grave and cry; I am not there.

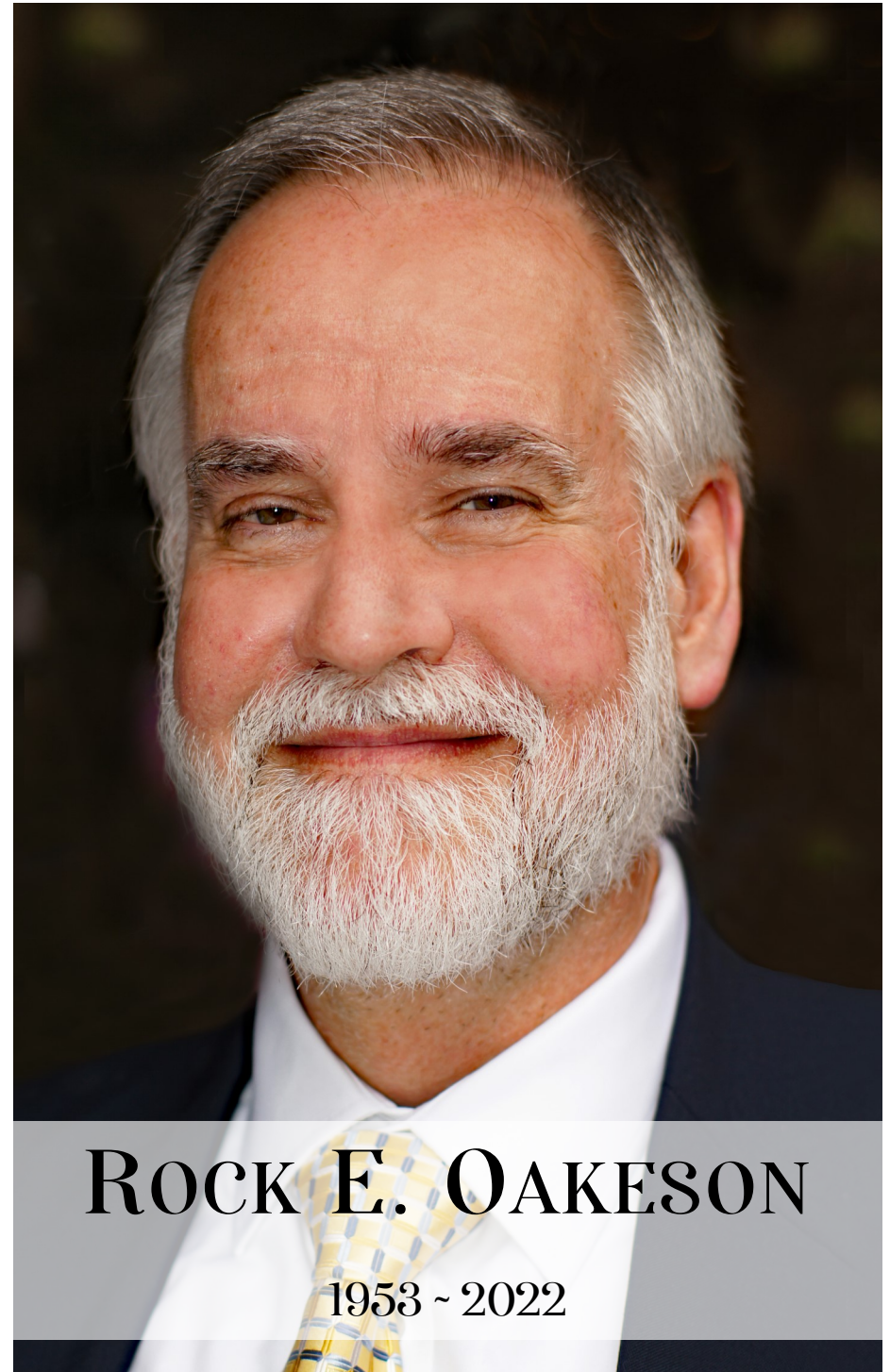
I did not die.
