

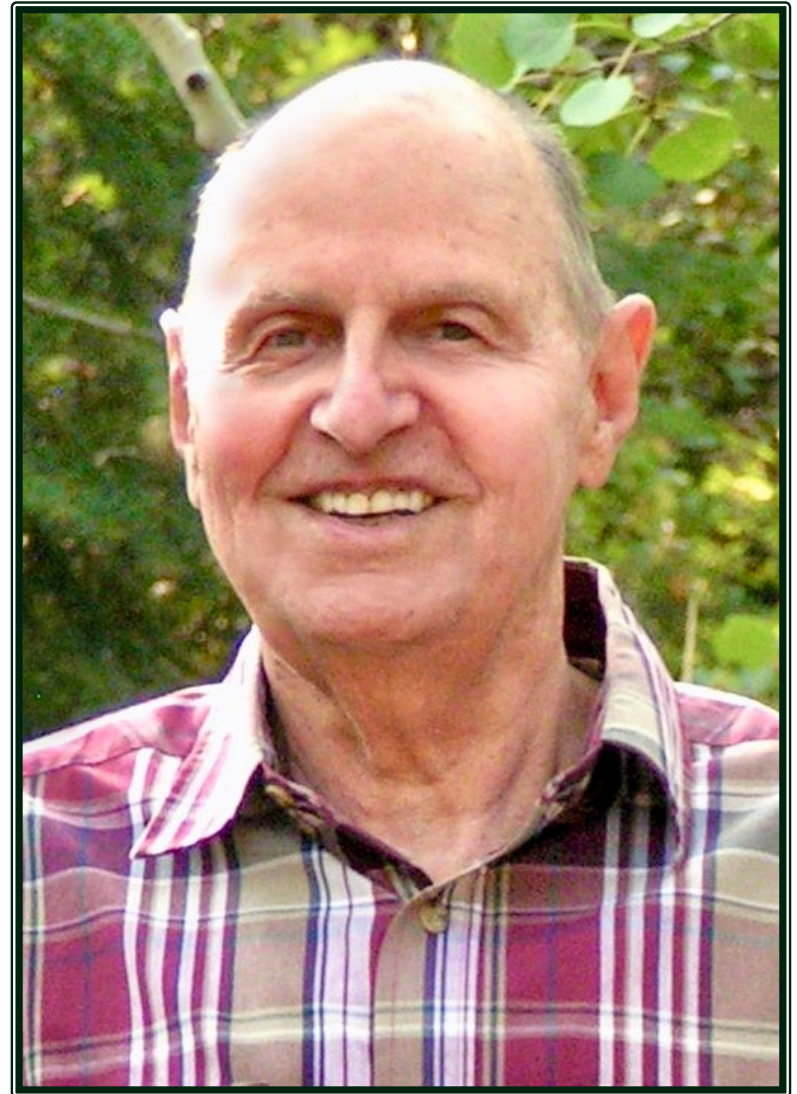
Amazing Grace
