 And cling to his faith through sorrow.

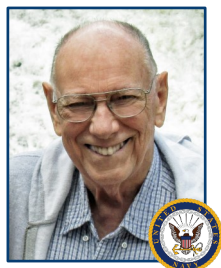
For truly forlorn is the man who weeps
