

ORDINANCE # 05-127

**BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN
OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE BEER ORDINANCE OF
THE TOWN OF UNICOI (#94-01)**

WHEREAS, Town of Unicoi Ordinance #94-01 which regulates the sale of beer within the town limits requires revision to ensure fair trade opportunities to local retailers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi wishes to provide equal competitive ability to local retailers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi wishes to revise the definition of measurement parameters by redefining specifics used to protect places of public gathering, in the interest of public safety,

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee by the virtue of the authority vested in this body by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Tennessee, do hereby pass ordinance to increase the number of beer permits allowed for beer sales within the Town of Unicoi city limits from three (3) to four (4), by revision of Section 8-110 of the Town of Unicoi Beer Ordinance and replace the last sentence of Section 8-111 with "The distances shall be measured in a straight line from the entrance to a building from which beer will be manufactured, stored or sold to the entrance of any hospital, school, church or other place of public gathering" .

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.


