

ORDINANCE 11- 203

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 97 – 30 TO PROVIDE THAT THE
DECLARATION OF ILLEGALITY OF ROADBLOCKS WITHIN THE TOWN OF
UNICOI SPECIFICALLY DOES NOT INCLUDE A ONCE ANNUAL ROADBLOCK BY
A SHRINE CLUB OR CLUBS COLLECTIVELY TO BENEFIT CHILDREN’S
HOSPITALS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN
OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Ordinance 97 – 30 is amended to provide that the declaration of roadblocks as illegal within the Town of Unicoi’s Public Streets and thoroughfares specifically does not include a once annual roadblock conducted by a Shrine Club or Shrine Clubs collectively to benefit children’s hospitals.
2. It shall be legal for a Shrine Club or Shrine Clubs collectively once a year to conduct a roadblock upon the public streets and thoroughfares of the Town of Unicoi for Shrine Paper sales to benefit Shrine children’s hospitals.
3. This ordinance shall be effective when passed on second reading, the public welfare requiring it.
