

ORDINANCE # 10 - 197

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI,
TENNESSEE TO ADD A 3-WAY STOP SIGNS ON
BRIGGS STREET**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in establishing safe driving conditions in the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the current speed limit on Briggs Street is twenty (20) miles per hour; and,

WHEREAS, two (2) speed calming devices have been installed on Briggs Street, which has slowed traffic in the areas of these devices; and,


WHEREAS, speeding is occurring between these two (2) speed calming devices; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Two (2) 3-Way Stop Signs shall be placed on Briggs Street at the intersection of Briggs Street and Brown Mill Road.
- Section 2. The penalty for each violation of this ordinance shall be punishable as a Class C Misdemeanor, with a fine of up to \$50.00 plus Town of Unicoi Municipal Court Costs.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
