

ORDINANCE 07- 152

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 00-67 OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE REPLACING SECTION 1-102 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE DEALING WITH DUTIES OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated* gives the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi the responsibility and opportunity to designate by ordinance certain operational duties and responsibilities to either the Mayor or the full Board; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor-Aldermanic Charter under which the Town operates, found in TCA 6-3-101 et. seq., defaults to a form of government which utilizes the Mayor as supervisor of the day to day affairs of the city and which utilizes Aldermen as the policy-making body; and

WHEREAS, the Town would like to return to the original framework offered by TCA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1: Section 1-102 of the *Unicoi Municipal Code* is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

1-102. Duties. (1) The Mayor shall supervise the day-to-day affairs of the Town. (2) The Mayor shall perform the duties set forth in Tennessee Code Annotated 6-3-106(b) and 6-4-101.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare of the town requiring it.


