

ORDINANCE # 02-101

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PARAMETERS FOR METHADONE CLINICS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. That the Unicoi, Tennessee Zoning Ordinance which was adopted and enacted, be amended by the addition of the following (in bold highlighting), as recommended by the Town of Unicoi Planning Commission:

ARTICLE III - DEFINITIONS:

352.5 Methadone Clinic; A facility providing medically supervised out-patient methadone treatment and counseling for addicts of heroin and other opiates, however, that patients are not kept overnight except under emergency conditions.

ARTICLE VII – PROVISIONS GOVERNING USE DISTRICTS

710. Manufacturing Warehouse Restricted Manufacturing and Warehouse District

710.4 Methadone Clinic.

710.4.1 May not be located within 2,000 feet of any school, day-care, park or church.

710.4.2 On lots that abut a residential district, the Unicoi Planning Commission may require all buildings and improvements be properly screened and shall be located so as to comply with the side yard requirements of the adjacent residential district.

711.M-2 Heavy Industrial District

711.8 Methadone Clinic.

711.8.1 May not be located within 2,000 feet of a day care, park or church.

711.8.2 On lots that abut a residential district, a Planning commission may require a lot owner to make improvements be properly screened and shall be located so as to comply with the side yard requirements of the adjacent residential district.


