

ORDINANCE 95-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI TENNESSEE CREATING A MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the board of mayor and aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee wish to promote the health, safety, welfare, and orderly growth of the Town of Unicoi, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that:

Section 1. Creation and membership. Pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, § 13-4-101 there is hereby created a municipal planning commission, hereinafter referred to as the planning commission. The planning commission shall consist of nine (9) members; two (2) of these shall be the mayor and another member of the board of mayor and aldermen selected by the board of mayor and aldermen; the other seven (7) members shall be appointed by the mayor. All members of the planning commission shall serve without compensation. Except for the initial appointments, the terms of the seven (7) members appointed by the mayor shall be for three (3) years each. The seven (7) members first appointed shall be appointed for terms of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), and seven (7) years respectively so that the term of one member expires each year. The terms of the mayor and the member selected by the board of mayor and aldermen shall run concurrently with their terms of office. Any vacancy in an appointive membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the mayor, who shall also have the authority to remove any appointive member at his will and pleasure.


Section 2. Organization, powers, duties, etc. The planning commission shall be organized and shall carry out its powers, functions, and duties in accordance with all applicable provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, title 13, chapter 4. *cmH*

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
