

ORDINANCE 00-68

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CONDUCT AT MEETINGS OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, ON REAL PROPERTY OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI AND AT ALL GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS AT ANY LOCATION OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that conduct of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, staff of the Town of Unicoi and all persons attending and or otherwise participating in administration and functioning of government within the Town of Unicoi be regulated, enforced and maintained in an orderly, proper and businesslike manner, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinances of the Town of Unicoi should contain rules for such conduct and regulation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the town of Unicoi as follows:

Section 1. No person shall commit on property of the Town of Unicoi or while participating in governmental functions of the Town of Unicoi at any location any act which, while not specifically prohibited by charter, ordinance or resolution of the Town of Unicoi, constitutes a misdemeanor under the statutes of the state or at common law and is punishable by state statute or common law by fine and/or imprisonment.

Section 2. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen may enforce orderly conduct at its meetings, and at any and all other times on the property of the Town of Unicoi and at any and all other governmental functions of the Town of Unicoi at any location. The Town of Unicoi may request or designate law enforcement personnel to serve as sergeant-at-arms for any meeting or other governmental function of the Town of Unicoi.

Section 3. Procedure for all meetings of the Town of Unicoi shall be conducted in substantial conformity with the procedure set forth in Robert's Rules of Order, modern edition, 1989.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
