

**ORDINANCE # 10 - 199**

**AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT LARGE TRUCKS ON  
STREETS AND ROADS IN THE TOWN OF UNICOI,  
TENNESSEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in establishing safe driving conditions in the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, there exists streets and roads within the boundaries of the Town of Unicoi that are too narrow, or have obstructions that create safety hazards when large trucks travel on them; and,

**WHEREAS**, safety hazards have occurred recently because large trucks using incorrect GPS information are becoming lost and entering congested areas within the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, the need has arisen to restrict large truck traffic as set out below; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Large trucks are defined as: semi-tractor trucks with trailers;
- Section 2. It is hereby prohibited and a violation of this ordinance for large trucks to proceed onto the restricted roads set out below, provided, however, it shall not be a violation of this ordinance for large trucks as defined herein to travel upon the hereinafter named and restricted roads for purposes of local deliveries, including but not limited to deliveries to Unicoi Elementary School and/or provision of moving services, after contacting the Town Hall and/or the Unicoi County Sheriff's Dispatch and obtaining permission, escort, alternate route directions and/or other services as necessary to protect health and safety and to prevent obstruction of the affected roadways;
- Section 3. Signage will be placed at the entrance(s) to the restricted roads prohibiting large trucks from turning onto the restricted roads;
- Section 4. Restricted Roads are as follows: Marbleton Road except from the southern intersection with Unicoi Drive to the end of Jones and Church Packing House Property and except from the northern intersection with Unicoi Drive west to the end, Springbrook Road to Rose Hill Lane, Golf Course Road, Massachusetts Avenue, Tennessee Street, Tinker Road




