

**ORDINANCE 95-8**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM AMOUNT FOR PURCHASES WITHOUT PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING**

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi is subject to the provisions of the provisions of the "Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983", and

WHEREAS, this law has been amended by Chapter No. 270, Public Acts of 1991, permitting municipalities to decrease the dollar amount of purchases requiring public advertisement and competitive bidding, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Unicoi to decrease said amount, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that:


Section 1. Public advertisement and competitive bidding shall be required for the purchase of all goods and services exceeding an amount of two hundred (\$200) except for those purchases specifically exempted from advertisement and bidding by Municipal Purchasing Act of 1983.


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
