AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE TO ADOPT MUNICIPAL COURT COSTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to adopt Municipal Court Costs;

WHEREAS, the Tennessee General Assembly has amended the laws pertaining to the
Municipal Court Costs for the collection of court operational costs; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN**, that we hereby set the Town of Unicoi Municipal Court costs at \$ 75.00
to be assessed for each and every ordinance violation.




