



ORDINANCE # 2015 – 244

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY WITHIN THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the Town of Unicoi Board of Mayor and Aldermen to provide for regulations to promote the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee and to provide for safe and secure travel in the Town and in around highway exits within the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby prohibited and a violation of this ordinance for any motor vehicle as previously defined within the statutes of the State of Tennessee incorporated into the Ordinances of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee, to park on the public rights of way within the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee.

Section 2. This prohibition shall extend beyond the paved right of way to the full extent and edge of the right of way dedicated to the Town of Unicoi or the State of Tennessee.

Section 3. The penalty for each violation of this ordinance shall be punishment as a Class C Misdemeanor, with a fine of up to \$50.00 in addition to the Town of Unicoi Municipal Court costs;

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring same.


