

ORDINANCE 95 - 19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI TENNESSEE
PROHIBITING CEMENT PLANTS

Whereas, the Town of Unicoi wishes to promote the health, safety, welfare, and general pleasure of its citizens, and tourism, and

Whereas, cement making industries produce particulate which may, harm those with respiratory disabilities, have heights and hazards which would inhibit firemen if a fire occurred at said industry, detract from tourism in sight, and,

Whereas, said industry is not at this time covered by planning and zoning regulations, and

Whereas, the Town wishes to put into place an ordinance which enumerates its position until the Unicoi Planning and Zoning Commission has considered this issue, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that:

Section 1. Cement, ^{and ready mix} manufacturing, or producing, plants and industries within the town limits of Unicoi are prohibited.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
