

## **ORDINANCE # 01-82**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE POLICY AND PURPOSE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, TO EXTEND TO EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS OF SAID TOWN OF UNICOI NOT EXCLUDED BY LAW OR THIS ORDINANCE WHETHER EMPLOYED IN CONNECTION WITH A GOVERNMENTAL OR PROPRIETARY FUNCTION OF SAID TOWN, THE BENEFITS OF THE FEDERAL SYSTEM OF OLD AGE, SURVIVORS, DISABILITY, HOSPITAL INSURANCE, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT; AS AMENDED, UPON THE BASIS OF APPLICABLE FEDERAL-STATE LAWS AND REGULATION. AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH THE DIRECTOR OF OLD AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE AGENCY, STATE OF TENNESSEE, AS AGENT OR AGENCY, FOR COVERAGE OF SAID EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE:**

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy and purpose of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee, to extend as of the date hereinafter set forth, to the employees and officials thereof, not excluded by law or this Ordinance and whether employed in connection with a governmental or proprietary function, the benefits of the Federal System of Old Age, Survivors, Disability, Hospital Insurance, as authorized by the Social Security Act, and Amendments thereto, including Public Law 734-1<sup>st</sup> Congress. In pursuance of said policy and for that purpose the said Town of Unicoi shall take such action as may be required by applicable Federal or State laws of regulations.

Section 2. The Mayor of the Town of Unicoi is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary agreements and amendments thereto with the Director of Old Age and Survivors Insurance Agency, State of Tennessee, as agent or agency, to provide coverage of the employees and officials as provided in Section 1. hereof.

The said Town of Unicoi shall keep such records and make such reports as may be required by applicable State or Federal laws or regulation.

There is hereby excluded from this Ordinance any authority to make any agreement with respect to any position or any employee not authorized to be covered under Federal State laws or regulations.

There is hereby excluded from this Ordinance, the services of election officials and election workers if the remuneration paid for such services is less than \$1100 in a calendar year, subject to adjustment for calendar years after 2001 to reflect changes in the economy during such calendar year, in accordance with Section 2189 ©(8)(B) of the Social Security Act.

The Agreement does not apply to services performed after July 1, 1991, that were mandatorily covered under Section 210 (7)(F) of the Social Security Act.


