AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ROAD BLOCKS IN THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE.


Be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee as follows:

The following Ordinances of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee was approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen upon second reading at the regular meeting held on 7/21/97, effective date, at this publication, the public requiring it:

ORDINANCE 97-29 AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM A-1 (AGRICULTURAL) TO R-3 (HIGH DENSITY) RESIDENTIAL WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE:

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi that the Unicoi, Tennessee Zoning Map which was adopted and enacted as part of the Unicoi Zoning Ordinance be amended as follows: that the property described below be rezoned from A-1 (Agricultural) to R-3 (High Density) Residential.

Being parcel 144.02 as shown on Unicoi County Tax Map 8.

Section 2. Be it further ordained that this public ordinance should take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
