

ORDINANCE # 08-163

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 16, SECTION 16 OF THE UNICOI MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A DRAINAGE TILE INSTALLATION POLICY

WHEREAS, citizens of the Town of Unicoi have requested assistance in installing drain tile under driveways;

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deems it to be in the best interests of the Town of Unicoi and the citizens of the Town to establish a policy regarding drainage tile which is of assistance to the citizenry and provides for uniform and regular treatment of citizen's requests to provide such assistance in order to promote adequate drainage within the Town adjacent to the roadways of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee that:

Title 16, Section 16 is hereby amended to add the following section:

- 16-111 Drainage Tile. The Town, upon request by citizens owning property with in the Town which abuts public right of way sufficient in area for installation of drainage tile, shall provide labor to install up to 20 feet of tile to serve one driveway for access to the citizen's residential property in accordance with the following conditions:
- (a) The landowner must call and have appropriate, necessary markings placed by TN 1-800-Dig;
 - (b) The landowner must pay for all tile, gravel and other material required for the installation.
 - (c) The Town shall not be responsible for any concrete or other headwall installation necessary for the tile installation. Responsibility for any headwall installation, both materials and labor, shall be the responsibility of the landowner seeking installation of the tile.
 - (d) The installation of drainage tile as aforesaid must take place only upon public right of way.


This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the same being required for the public welfare.


