

ORDINANCE 10 - 202

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 BUDGET AS PASSED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 09-178 OF THE TOWN GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF UNICOI AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi adopted the fiscal year 2009-2010 budget by passage of Ordinance Number 09-178 on June 15, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee state constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the *Tennessee Code Annotated* section 6-56-209, the Board of Mayor and Alderman has the authority to authorize the budget officer to transfer moneys from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and,

WHEREAS, revenues for the FY 2009 – 2010 were less than anticipated; and,

WHEREAS, expenses for the FY 2009 – 2010 were less than anticipated; and,

WHEREAS, the attached 5 page spreadsheet contains the monetary details and explanations is in its entirety part of this ordinance amendment; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE THAT CHANGES BE MADE TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 BUDGET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance Number 09-178 is hereby amended by decreasing Revenues by \$ 322,454.46 and decreasing Expenses by \$ 204,317.73 and decreasing the Fund Balance by \$ 103,981.57.

SECTION 2. The Board of Mayor and Alderman authorizes the city recorder to make said changes in the accounting system.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.

passengers from that vehicle; provided, that the vehicle is stopped so that a clear view of the vehicle shall be obtained from a distance of two hundred feet (200') in each direction, upon the roads, streets or highways.

Section 5. Section 1. shall not apply to a solid waste vehicle while on the paved or improved main traveled portion of a road, street or highway in a manner and to an extent as is necessary for the sole purpose of collecting solid waste, as defined by state law, provided that the vehicle shall maintain flashing hazard lights at all times while it is stopping or standing; provided further, that the vehicle is stopped so that a clear view of the stopped vehicle shall be available from a distance of two hundred feet (200') in either direction upon the highway.

Section 6. Violation of this ordinance shall be a Class C Misdemeanor and shall be punishable by fine of up to \$50.00 plus Town of Unicoi Municipal Court Costs.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.


