

## **ORDINANCE # 2013 - 224**

### **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2011 – 207 TO RESTRICT LARGE TRUCKS ON STREETS AND ROADS IN THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in establishing safe driving conditions in the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, there exists streets and roads within the boundaries of the Town of Unicoi that are too narrow, or have obstructions that create safety hazards when large trucks travel on them; and,

**WHEREAS**, safety hazards have occurred recently because large trucks using incorrect GPS information are becoming lost and entering congested areas within the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, the need has arisen to expand the restriction of large truck traffic as set out below; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1      Section 1 of Ordinance 2011 – 207 is hereby amended by adding Powder Hollow Road and will now read as follows:

Restricted Roads are as follows: Marbleton Road except from the southern intersection with Unicoi Drive to the end of Jones and Church Packing House Property and except from the northern intersection with Unicoi Drive west to the end, Springbrook Road, Golf Course Road except to the pro shop, Massachusetts Avenue, Tennessee Street, Tinker Road except from I-26 interchange to Rocky Bottom Road, Washington Street except to the Unicoi Volunteer Fire Department, Zane Whitson Drive and Powder Hollow Road;

Section 2      No change

This ordinance will go into effect following its passage on the second and final reading.




