

# ORDINANCE 99-47

## TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE

### SPEED LIMITS

Wherein the Town of Unicoi pursuant to the powers vested to it as a Town under the laws of the State of Tennessee hereby desires to set speed limits within the corporate limits:

1. The speed limit within the Town of Unicoi shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour in all areas or upon all public thoroughfares unless otherwise designated. The following establishes speed limits that are exceptions to the citywide 35 miles per hour limit:
  - A. The speed limit shall be thirty (30) miles per hour on State Route 107 (Limestone Cove Road) from the eastern Unicoi line to Unicoi Drive.
  - B. The speed limit shall be 20 miles per hour in all areas covered by a radius of two-tenths (.2) of a mile from the Unicoi Elementary School property.
  - C. The speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour on all of Marbleton Road located on the east side of Unicoi Drive.
  - D. On that portion of Marbleton Road located on the west side of Unicoi Drive, the speed limit is hereby increased from fifteen (15) miles per hour to twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
  - E. The speed limit shall be thirty (30) miles per hour on Scott Lane.
  - F. All other speed limits that were in effect prior to this ordinance shall remain in effect.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage, the public Welfare requiring it.
