

## ORDINANCE # 10 - 200

### AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON PROPERTIES OWNED BY THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in establishing conditions to protect the beauty and usefulness of properties owned by or used by in the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, there exists properties owned by or used by the Town of Unicoi that are useful by the citizens of the town and surrounding area and attractive to the community; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in maintaining and protecting these properties for the use and enjoyment of everyone who lives here or visits our town; and,

**WHEREAS**, the need has arisen to restrict motorized vehicles as described in Section 1 to streets, roads, driveways and parking facilities on properties as described in Section 3 by ordinance; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Motor Vehicles are defined as: Any motorized vehicle of any size including but not restricted to cars, trucks, busses, motorcycles and ATV's. Motor Vehicles within the meaning of this ordinance specifically does not mean any vehicle designed and used for handicapped persons mobility and access to these properties and further does not mean any maintenance or work vehicle being used by the Town and/or any of its' agents or subsidiaries for the improvement and/or maintenance of the property:
- Section 2. It is hereby prohibited and a violation of this ordinance to operate a motor vehicle on the restricted properties set out in Section 4. below;
- Section 3. Signage describing this restriction will be placed at the obvious entrance(s) and at other potential entrance locations to these properties.
- Section 4. Restricted Properties pursuant to this ordinance are as follows: 3600 Unicoi Drive, 5012 Unicoi Drive, 101 Powder Hollow Road, 507

except from I-26 interchange to Rocky Bottom Road, Washington Street except to the Unicoi Volunteer Fire Department and Zane Whitson Drive;

Section 5. The penalty for each violation of this ordinance shall be punishable as a Class C Misdemeanor, with a fine of up to \$50.00 plus Town of Unicoi Municipal Court Costs;

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.


