

**TOWN OF UNICOI
ORDINANCE # 08-171**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI,
TENNESSEE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 07-149 TO
ALLOW BEER SALES ON ELECTION DAY**

Whereas, the Beer Board of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee has received a request to change the beer sales hours on Election Day; and,

Whereas, the Beer Board of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee recommends this change in beer sales hours on Election Day; and,

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deems it appropriate to amend Ordinance 07-149 to change the beer sales hours on Election Day;

Now therefore, be it ordained, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that Section 8-104 read as follows:

8-104. Hours and days of sale, etc., regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, joint stock company, syndicate, or association to offer for sale or sell beer or other alcoholic beverage with an alcoholic content not exceeding five per centum (5%) by weight within the corporate limits of Unicoi, Tennessee between the hours of three o'clock (3:00) a.m., and eight o'clock (8 :00) a.m. on weekdays, or between the hours of three o'clock (3:00) a.m. and 12:00 noon on Sundays. No such beverages shall be consumed or opened for consumption on or about any premises where beer or other beverages with an alcoholic content not exceeding five per centum (5%) of weight is sold within the corporate limits of Unicoi, Tennessee in either bottle, glass or other container after three-fifteen o'clock (3:15) a.m.

*This section now excludes the following phrase:
or on election days before and while the polls are lawfully open*

This ordinance shall take effect from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.




