

**ORDINANCE # 10 - 198**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI,  
TENNESSEE TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT ON  
MASSACHUSETTS AVENUE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 96 - 26**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Unicoi are interested in establishing safe speed limits for vehicles traveling in the Town; and,

**WHEREAS**, Title 15, Chapter I of the Municipal Code of the Town of Unicoi, states that a speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour will apply in the Town unless otherwise designated; and,

**WHEREAS**, the speed limit on Massachusetts Avenue is currently twenty (20) miles per hour from the railroad crossing to Jackson Street and thirty (30) miles per hour from Jackson Street to the western town limit; it shall be reduced to twenty (20) miles per hour over the entire length of the street in the interest of public safety; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The speed limit shall be reduced to twenty (20) miles per hour on the entire length of Massachusetts Avenue.
- Section 2. The penalty for each violation of this ordinance shall be punishable as a Class C Misdemeanor, with a fine of up to \$50.00 plus Town of Unicoi Municipal Court Costs.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the public welfare requiring it.




