ORDINANCE 95-12

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF UNICOI TENNESSEE
ABANDONING JONES ROAD**

WHEREAS, the board of mayor and aldermen of the Town of Unicoi, Tennessee is committed to providing for its citizens, and the citizens of Unicoi County, the improved ability for obtaining adequate employment, income and lifestyles, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi does rightfully own the road/street known as Jones Road, being situated within the boundaries of the Town of Unicoi, connecting and being near perpendicular to Highway 36 and Whitson Drive; and transversing an industrial development site which is being prepared for occupancy by Specialty Tires of America (Tennessee), and

WHEREAS, the Town of Unicoi desires to promote good relationships for the citizens, government, and industry in Unicoi County, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that:


Section 1. The Town of Unicoi does hereby abandon all claim to the road/street known as Jones Road, being situated within the boundaries of the Town of Unicoi, connecting and being near perpendicular to Highway 36 and Whitson Drive; and transversing an industrial development site which is to be occupied by Speciality Tires of America (Tennessee), a subsidiary of Polymer Enterprises Inc., and that all rights to said Jones Road and its rights of way shall become the property of the owners of said property, to have and hold and do as they please.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
