

Driver Liability Form

I want to encourage students to drive, but only once they become safe drivers. I understand that quite a few of the student's have formed friendships and wish to carpool or drive together. We do not have a problem with this as long as parents grant permission by signing the statement below. This form must be submitted in order for students to be able to leave on break.

**Students must take ADAP (Alcohol Drug and Awareness Program) at the vocational school prior to earning their driver's license. Students must also take the Joshua's Law courses. For more information, see the school handbook.

Penalties for students: The *Teenage and Adult Driver Responsibility Act* requires that a driver's license shall NOT be issued or shall be revoked for a period of one year if a student is 14-17 years old and has (1) dropped out of school and remained out of school for ten consecutive days; (2) accumulated TEN or more unexcused absences during the previous academic year; (3) a student's license shall be revoked if they miss TEN or more days for the current school year. A form of noncompliance will be filed with the Georgia Department of Motor Vehicles and the student's license will be suspended.
