We will have a large number of spoons and bowls carved by the forest knights team to offer inspiration for you to discover your own style. Every hand crafted spoon is a work of art and yours will be the envy of your friends. Once you have mastered the basic skills you soon be making spoons for all your friends and family. Your day starts at 09:30 at Amberley station where you will be met by a member of the Forest Knights team and escorted to the Greenwood Village at the museum. After a welcome cup of tea and biscuits sitting around our camp fire we will learn about the differet properties of wood and cutting tools before heading out into the museum to select material to create our spoons.

12:30 we break for lunch. You are welcome to use the Limeburners Resturant or relax in our camp and enjoy your own packed lunch. After lunch you will now put your new carving skills to good use creating your own spoon or ladle. During the afternoon you will learn how to finish and care for your spoon to ensure it becomes a treasured heirloom.

3:30 We shall stop carving to allow us to enjoy a final brew and admire our new creations. We will also discuss how to sharpen and care for our tools.
