All exhibitors must **arrive by 10.00** (when we open to the public) and stay on display until the 16.00 ride-out (Exhibitors are not obliged to leave at this time and are welcome to stay until 17.00 when the Museum closes) For public safety reasons scooters/vehicles are not permitted to move between 10.00 and 16.00. As entry/exit from the site is via a remote-controlled barrier, permission to leave between these times must be obtained from the duty manager.

Amberley Museum endeavours to be accessible to all persons including those with mobility difficulties but please note we are an open air, countryside site and cannot guarantee that any particular parking position will be available to exhibitors. Modern vehicles on site must be parked out of sight in designated areas.
