All live steam entries must have current boiler inspection certification and insurance. All working models must be covered by Public Liability Insurance and operated by competent persons.


The exhibitors' gate will be open from 17:00 to 20:00 on Friday 14th and between 08:00 and 10:00 on Saturday and Sunday. Arrivals cannot be accepted during the public opening hours between 10:00 and 17:00 on any day. Please indicate your arrival time and day on the entry form.

We have limited caravan/motor home parking for overnight use. We cannot accept tents as all parking is on hardstanding. The operator of the exhibit and one passenger arriving with the exhibit are admitted free of charge. Extra passengers are subject to the special rate of £5.00 per person payable in advance with your entry form (see opposite). Organisations and societies can book using the form opposite, please enclose a covering note to include information on your stand and named persons who would be in attendance/operating.
