Entry to the event and the Museum is **free of charge to exhibitors**, one additional adult and up to three children arriving with the exhibit(s). A £5 per head fee applies for any additional passengers, payable in advance with your entry from. A commemorative programme and brass attendance plaque will be available to each entry.

(If entering more than two cycles please enclose a separate sheet with your entry) **Please include a c5 stamped self-addressed envelope with your entry.** The closing date for applications will be **Friday 13**th **July**.

Please note that cycles, carrying vehicles and stallholders **must arrive on site between 8.30am and 10.00am** and cannot leave (without prior permission from the Duty Manager) until 5.00pm. Early arrivals should park in the station car park until 8.30am. All modern vehicles on site will be parked out of sight of the public. We have special parking arrangements for exhibitors with disabilities so please let us know your requirements on your entry form.
