AUTUMN HISTORIC TRANSPORT GATHERING

SUNDAY 7TH OCTOBER 2018

This year the Autumn Historic Vehicles Gathering celebrates 40 years since the first event held at the Museum in 1978. We aim to make it a special occasion with every possible part of the Museum 'at work'.

If you were an exhibitor in the early days of events at Amberley, please note the year you first attended on the entry form. You may get a privileged parking position if space allows.

This gathering is open to all forms of motor transport, cycles and stationary engines but exhibits must be at least 50 years old, i.e. built by the end of October 1968. Entry places for cars and motorcycles will be allocated by age groups to ensure a representative display.

As this is a public display event we do ask that you commit to arriving by 10.00am when the Museum opens. The successful exhibits departure to a commentary in 2017 will be repeated with dispersal between 4:15 and 5:00pm.

There is no entry fee for the driver, one adult passenger and any school age children arriving in the vehicle, although any donation is always more than welcome! A £5 each concession admission is available for any additional adult passengers, payable in advance with your entry form. Normal Museum admission rates apply to any other supporters.

Amberley Museum endeavours to be accessible to all persons including anyone with mobility difficulties but please note we are an open air, countryside site and cannot guarantee any particular parking position will be available to exhibitors. Please advise us if you are a 'blue badge' holder.

If you would like to apply for a place at this event, please complete the entry form opposite and return it to the Museum with a **c5** stamped SAE.

No applications will be accepted once our entry limits are reached or after 24th September, whichever is the earlier. This event is regularly oversubscribed and because of space, safety, ground conditions and your comfort we are obliged to limit the number of acceptances. We are sorry but except for certain pre 1914 vehicles, cycles and stationary engines NO transported exhibits can be accepted as our space limitations give us very limited parking space for tender vehicles.
