OUR FACILITIES

Improvements and additions are made annually. Volunteers regularly maintain the facilities. Some of the outstanding features of the park include:

- 250' x 175' fenced outdoor sand riding ring with lights, sound and water wagon
- Second fenced outdoor sand ring, 250' x 175'
- Limestone unfenced warm-up area
- Bleacher seating to accommodate spectators
- Stadium and hunter jumps
- 74 10' x 10' stalls, steel gates, water access at each barn, electric and wash area
- Handicapped accessible restroom facility
- 24' x 32' all-purpose building with annex, electric and running water utilized for registration and announcer's booth for show management
- 30' x 32' covered pavilion with picnic tables
- Over 8 miles of hiking and riding trails
- Plenty of parking space for trucks and trailers
- Headquarters for the Buckeye Horse Park Association, Inc. is a nine room century house which is available for meetings, clinics and small gatherings



ABOUT US

Buckeye Horse Park Association was established in 1992. This 501C3 non-profit organization serves to manage and provide facilities at the Buckeye Horse Park, which enhance the experience of the equine enthusiast through competition, education, charitable outreach and environmental & community development. Most events are open to the public.

Buckeye Horse Park is located on Route 224, just three miles west of the center of Canfield, Ohio at 9260 Akron-Canfield Rd in Ellsworth Township. In 1994, Buckeye Horse Park Association, Inc. leased 47 acres from Mill Creek MetroParks and established Buckeye Horse Park. The Park is adjacent to the Vickers Nature Preserve and may be leased for at least fifty years. Buckeye Horse Park and Buckeye Horse Park Association are not supported by Mahoning County tax levies or by the Mill Creek Metroparks. Buckeye Horse Park Association is a non-profit (501C3) organization financially supported by annual membership dues, fundraising, grants, park rental fees, shows, clinics and donations.

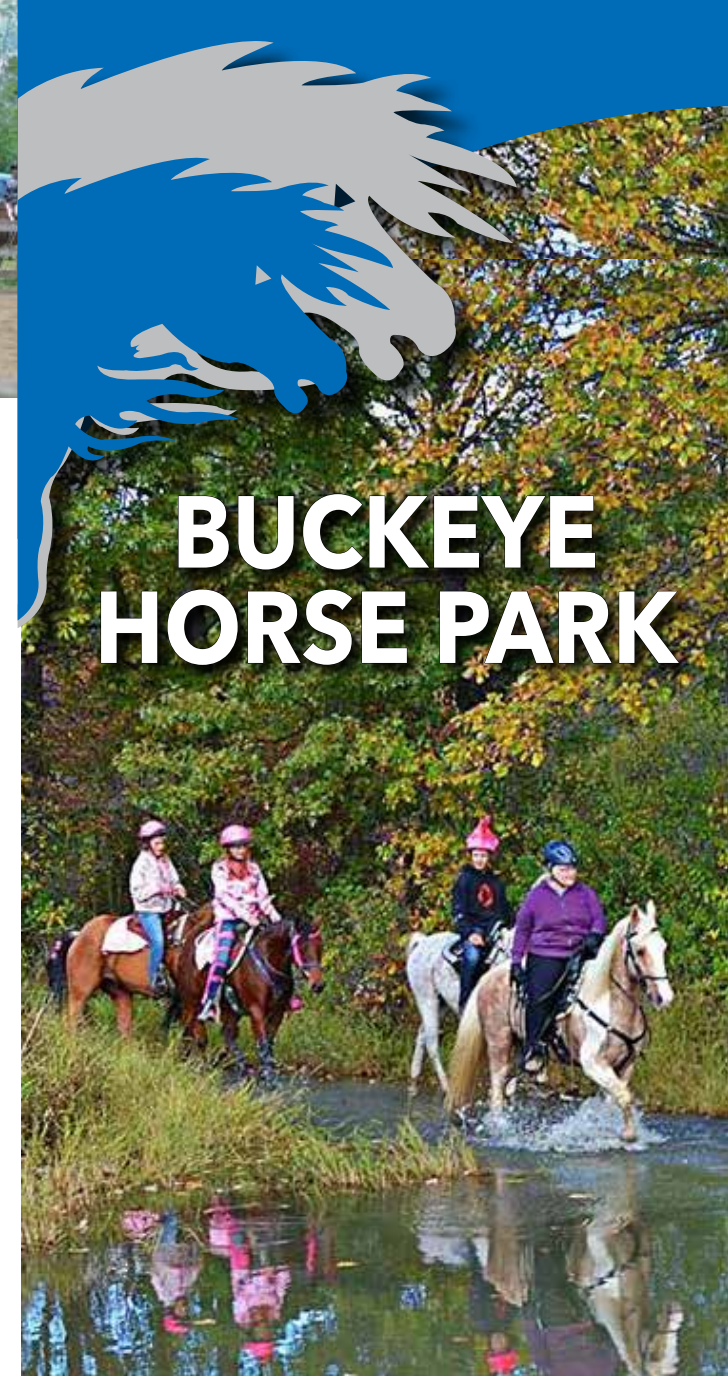
