Please pardon our mess. Over the last few weeks we've had ceiling

tiles come down in several rooms and, as a result, your congregation council took the proactive step of initiating the replacement of the ceiling in every room where those particular tiles were to be found. That meant moving everything from heavy furniture to the small scraps and supplies we've accumulated over the years, and much of that has found its way into hallways and other inconvenient places. This process has meant messy, dusty work and the appearance that our building has suffered a flood. It's meant moving classes and making other arrangements for our midweek meals and services. Add this to the plumbing issues we've faced in recent months and it's enough to make one look around and wonder whether or not this old barn is worth the effort! Might it not be easier to find a newer building with less maintenance needs?

I suppose that would be a fair question, but really it's clear these issues are all fixable problems. Our building is still standing strong and will, I believe, for some time. If that is our desire, then the work of taking care of it must be done. Of course, the cost and the effort do add up. Every check written and every hour spent working tax our resources. And since that's the case it is worth asking what purpose is served by these efforts. There are of course many different ways of answering that. Our building hosts quite a few different types of events on a regular basis, some just for members and others more for the benefit of the community. But our building is first and foremost a place where we come to encounter God. It is a place where we share in a unique experience, one that has the power to uplift and transform our lives even when it begins to seem routine or mundane. Naturally

God's presence can be experienced any place in His creation, but what happens here is an event in which our time and focus are exclusively set aside for the reception of God's promises in a setting dedicated to that relationship.

We keep our building strong because it's an investment in the gifts we receive here. We use it to hear and teach the Word, to sit together and be fed and nourished, to joyfully share in the fun of this life, and to reverently approach the means by which God's grace is conveyed to us. We invest our resources into this place because it's a monument to what our God has invested in us. Christ, the Son of God, came into this world to share a presence in our lives and to invest his life in us. By his sacrifice and his faithfulness we all share an eternal place in God's household. This place and other buildings like it are the places for those moments we set aside to recognize that household in this world.

Whether it's sparkling or a dusty disaster, this building is a gift because it's where you and I get to come together and belong to a family of grace. When you walk in the door and grab a bulletin or a cup of coffee, remember where you are and give thanks for the resource we have and the privilege of serving it.


