Green Career Day (Serving Bradford, Sullivan and Tioga Counties)

Just like the name implies, Green Career Day is an educational program that is all about providing hands-on learning opportunities to high school students potentially interested in pursuing an environmental/outdoor oriented career after they graduate. This program is annually held at Mt. Pisgah State Park and has provided attending students with a great opportunity to learn about what to expect and how to prepare themselves for a job in everything from soil science, forestry, landscaping, environmental resource management, wildlife biology, fisheries, horticulture, sustainable energy, and many others. For the last several years that this event has been held at the park, BCCD has assisted DCNR, who is the main official organizing and sponsoring agency for this program, with logistical support, planning, coordination and program facilitation duties. In 2015 this program served 145 students coming from 11 schools across Bradford County while providing 35 different green career station options to students across multiple environmental fields.
