Pre-workshop Information

This workshop is designed to teach you how to use the PA OneStop web based farm mapping and planning application. PA OneStop is offered thru Penn State Extension and is available for free to all farmers/producers. The program is designed to help you write the PA required Ag. Erosion and Sedimentation control plan. It allows producers to map their farm, add crop rotation information, and make changes to the plan as farm management and crop rotation changes. The maps you produce also work well for the PA required Manure Management Plan.

To help reduce the wait time during the workshop, please do the following beforehand:

1. Mozilla Firefox internet browser is the most compatible for PA OneStop. Download the latest version of Mozilla Firefox onto your computer. It is a free program. When you go to www.paonestop.org you can click on the link that says "Get firefox now"
2. Open the Firefox web browser and Go to www.paonestop.org and create a Login and Password for your farm.
 - Click on "Begin Mapping"
 - Click "Create New User Account"
 - Enter your contact information, username, and password. Click "Create User Account"
3. Remember the user name and password so you can login to your account at the workshop (Computers will be provided at the workshop so you do not need to bring yours with you).

Your farm information is secure. PA OneStop is maintained by Penn State University Cooperative Extension and information related to any individual farm will not be shared with or distributed to any other organization without permission of the individual farmer.
