

BBQ and Twilight Pond Walk

Please join BCCD on Friday, May 18th for a relaxing evening on the property of Robert and Mary Frey in Rome Township as they invite you to experience the joy of wildlife diversity through natural pond management.

We will begin the evening at 6:00pm with opening remarks from BCCD followed by a catered bbq meal (brisket on a toasted pretzel roll, baked beans, cole slaw, drinks, and dessert) from Antler Ridge Winery.

After dinner, Mr. Frey will give an enthusiastic tour of his ponds and talk about habitat diversity, natural aquatic landscaping, and the flora and fauna that call his ponds home. If weather permits, we will conclude the evening by toasting marshmallows over a campfire at sunset while listening to a chorus of American toads, spring peepers, and tree frogs!
