- Bradford County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program and Board were established by the county commissioners in 2001.
- The Farmland Preservation
   Board has allocated over \$3.5
   million dollars protecting
   farmland and the future of out county's agriculture heritage.
- As of 2018, 17 farms have been protected, totaling over 4,000 acres.
- Each year applicant farms are ranked according to soil quality, farmland potential and threat of development.
