The minutes of the February 8, 2016 meeting were approved as printed.

ORDINANCE & RESOLUTION: 3rd reading of Ord. 560 trash ordinance new ordinance with changes is ORD. 2016-04/560. upon vote of council ORD 2016-04/560 fails.

CORRESPONDENCE: Mayor Johnson read message from USPS on post office, grand opening is set for 4-4-2016.

SAFETY COMMITTEE: Repeaters for cruisers deemed inoperable due to improper installation cost for repair is \$450.00 each. New radios would cost \$3200.00 each. Mr. Johnson will look into grants to purchase new radios. Mr. Flood motioned to fix repeaters at a cost of \$900.00, 2nd by Mr. Flood II. Votes are as follows YEAS Johnson, Flood II, Owston, Flood, Heider NAYS . motion carries. The 12 volt system was damaged when repeaters were removed. Two officers resigned. Easter egg hunt on 3/20/16 @ 12:00. Sgt. Roberts would like to purchase excess camera that is not in service. Mr. Flood motioned to sell at \$1.00 each Mr. Flood II 2nd . Votes are as follows YEAS Flood II, Owston, Heider, Flood, Johnson NAYS. Motion carries.

BUILDING COMMITTEE: Need to set up room for election, Chief will open for poll workers.

FINANCE: Clerk to attend LGS conference. Audit is under way for 2014/2015

STREETS, SIDEWALKS, DRAINS AND DITCHES COMMITTEE: Mr. Flood II said resident told him that Col. Gas workers tracked mud through the house also the culvert at Blose & Mulberry was cracked.

PARKS & RECREATION: Mr. Toby Spencer won the rifle from veterans park committee. Mr. Flood motioned to spend approximately \$5500.00 to begin concrete work and purchase flag poles for Veterans Park, and by Mr. Flood II. Votes are as follows Owston, Flood, Heider,

Johnson, Flood II, NAYS. Motion carries. Mayor is making a shadow box with items from Veterans Park. The one available pole that was donated will go to the community park. Ground breaking for park on 3/20/2016 @1:00.


Vote on said motion was as follows: Yeas, Johnson, Flood, Heider, Flood II, Owston Nays, none. Motion carried.


