

The Village of Tremont Council met in open session on Monday July 9, 2018 at 7:30 PM in the Village Council chambers.

Mr. Smith led the council in the Pledge of Allegiance and welcomed Mark Sanders and Stephanie Lutz to the meeting.

The minutes for June 25th were presented for review. Approved as written. Mr. Griffith will not be able to attend the July 23rd meeting due to a work commitment.

No new ordinances presented.

CORRESPONDENCE: Monthly bills were presented. Motion to pay by Tony Flood I, second by Tony Flood II. 5 yeas, motioned carried. The second reading of Ordinance 2018-14 was done.

SAFETY COMMITTEE: It was brought up that several village residents are emptying their drains into the ditches and that causing the flooding to be worse in some areas. As long as the drains are not blocking the roads, it is allowed. The possibility of an ordinance on the matter was mentioned. It will be looked into. Chief Nelson submitted the monthly report for June and the report for the first half of 2018. Unit 562 will be taken to Jeff Wyler's to have diagnostics ran. It was noted that several stop signs around town are faded and bent and need to be replaced.

FINANCE: Board of Elections needs to be notified of the Clerk position being replaced with a Fiscal Officer. July 30, 2018, there will be a finance committee meeting at 6:30 PM.

BUILDING COMMITTEE: Tony Flood II was able to check out the breaker box in the clerk's office and will take care of making sure it is covered.

STREETS, SIDEWALKS, DRAINS, AND DITCHES COMMITTEE: Tony Flood II noted that the stop sign on the northbound stop sign at the corner of Third of Blose is blocked by a tree. The council agreed the tree needs taking down as money permits. It was decided that a 2 sided crosswalk sign on the park side of the road for the crosswalk to the community park would be the best option. Mayor Smith will call OOPS and have it marked so David Baker can place the sign. The drain in front of Denise Skaggs has flooded during the last few heaving rains. Several options were discussed at length and are being explored. Mark Sanders offered to help as much as he can, any way he can.

PARKS & RECREATION: The pallets have been removed from the community park. The committee is still waiting for the manual referenced in the PEP safety audit. The car show will be September 1st. It was offered that the Athletic Committee from Northwestern may be willing to

help out for a small donation. There will be a car show meeting at 6:30PM, prior to the July 23rd meeting.
