The minutes of the September 24th, 2018 were approved as printed.

CORRESPONDENCE: Monthly bills presented, motion to pay by Erin Nichols, 2nd by Tony Flood II, 5 years, 1 nay, motion passed. Audit invoice received from the Auditor of State, State Farm just touched base about the plow truck claim, Clark County Board of Elections asked for permission to use the municipal building for a voting place on Nov 6., council agreed to allow it.

SAFETY COMMITTEE: New officer William Dick was sworn in by the Mayor. Council asked that written warnings be done along with the verbal warnings. Estimate for \$532 to fix the radio received, motioned to approve the bill along with fixing the tail light for up to \$100 by Tony Flood 2nd by Tony Flood II, 6 years, motioned passed. Nothing was found wrong mechanically with 562. Tony Flood II is getting estimates for a bumper for the plow truck.

FINANCE: Fiscal officer is still working on getting the budget done in the UAN.

BUILDING COMMITTEE: Motion for the Mayor to purchase plastic for up to \$150 to put in the park building to try to contain the bat problem by Tony Flood, 2nd by William Griffith, 6 years motion passed.

STREETS, SIDEWALKS, DRAINS, AND DITCHES COMMITTEE: Tony Flood II will be getting a quote for a plow motor.

PARKS & RECREATION: The events committee would like to plant mums and roses in the Veteran's Park, Motion to approve by Tony Flood II, 2nd by Erin Nichols, 6 years, motion passed. Northwestern PeeWee would like to have their banquet hog roast/bonfire on Nov 10th at the Community Park building. Motion to allow by Tony Flood, 2nd by Erin Nichols, 6 years motion passed. There is still no word on official ownership of the cemetery. German Township has shown interest in ownership. They would also like to have a working relationship with the village. David Foster would like to contract with the village to take care of the Veteran's Park. The Veteran's Committee will discuss that at their meeting Monday Oct. 22 at 6:30. PM.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: Mike Muska wanted council to know that the repairs to Owners Drive is holding up to traffic. Tony Flood II mentioned that the flags around town need to be taken

down. David Foster stated that council should send a card to an ill village resident. Council let him know that was something the council would decide to do individually if they wanted. Christina Flood, court clerk asked that all tickets be turned in by Sunday night to have the records ready in time for court.
