The minutes for October 8, 2018 were presented for review. Approved as corrected

CORRESPONDENCE: Insurance walk-through to be done Nov 1, 2018, PEP paperwork for next year's insurance, and State Farm letter pertaining to plow truck.

SAFETY COMMITTEE: Officer Austin Garret Murphy sworn in, 7 of 8 officers attended qualifications and qualified, Tony Flood II will put new wheel bearing in 561 if needed, Tony Flood motioned, Erin Nichols 2nd, 6 yeas, motioned carried. Officers will be available for Beggar's Night. Tony Flood motioned to spend up to \$249 for a plow pump for the truck if needed, 2nd Steve Heider, 6 yeas motioned carried.

FINANCE: First reading of Ordinance 2018-18, temp budget for next year will be done as next meeting.

BUILDING COMMITTEE: Chad Duncan rented the park building to be used for the Haunted Garage, it will open at 8pm. Plastic will be hung up after Beggar's Night. Less bats are in the building. The Peewee banquet is moved to Nov. 11 from noon-4 or 5. Motion to pay Erin Nichols \$50 for fridge by Denise Ingerman, 2nd by Tony Flood, 5 yeas motioned carried, Erin Nichols abstained.

STREETS, SIDEWALKS, DRAINS, AND DITCHES COMMITTEE: When the plow truck comes back, Tony Flood II will make sure it's ready for winter.

PARKS & RECREATION: Parks close at dusk, if a citizen sees someone in either one after that they need to call the Sheriff's office. Mayor Smith said the roses and mums look good at the Veteran's Park. The Veteran's Committee has asked the fiscal officer to hold brick orders for 30 days after payment is received and then order, no matter how many there are. There will be a Veteran's Committee meeting at 6:30pm on December 10th. Community park flag needs replaced. Motion for Fiscal Officer to buy a new flag for \$48 by Tony Flood, 2nd by Steve Heider, 5 yeas, one nay, motion carried. Motion to cancel flag purchase by Tony Flood, 2nd by Tony Flood II, 5 yeas, one nay, motioned carried. Steve Heider will donate flag. Several citizens would like to volunteer to tend to the Veteran's Park, Sgt. Chad Duncan and David Foster would like to volunteer as well.

The December 24th meeting has been moved to December 17, due to the holiday.

Motion for Fiscal Officer to buy up to \$ 250 of candy for Beggar's Night for the Village officials and police officers to hand out along with paying the rest of the bills by Tony Flood, 2nd by Denise Ingerman, 6 yeas motioned passed.
