Patrol Buddies

This season we're planning to pilot a new program called "Patrol Buddies". The idea of one of our young Nippers, Rachel Huxley, the program aims to bridge the gap between our young members and patrollers.

Nippers between the age of 8 and 13 will be invited to sign up to join the first hour of patrols. They'll help with setting up the patrol, learning where to place the flags, running through equipment checks, checking the beach, performing checks of first aid equipment and meeting and greeting visitors to the beach. Depending on conditions they may even have a chance to try out the rescue boards with one of the patrollers.

We're planning to start rolling out the program in December and will keep you posted. In the meantime, we need patrollers over the age of 18 to get their Working With Children Check so we can run it smoothly.

Working with Children Check

All NSW Surf Life Saving (SLS) Club members and employees (over the age of 18 years) require a WWCC if they have a child-related role. The online application is a quick process - it takes only a couple of minutes. Once you complete the application and obtain your number you just need to take your application number and proof of identity to a NSW Motor Registry, Government Access Centre or Service NSW Office. Bermagui SLSC is proud to have Level Accreditation under the Good Sports Program.

Good Sports is a national accreditation program of the Australian Drug Foundation

(ADF) which works to make community sporting clubs healthy, safe and family friendly environments. There are more than 5,700 community sporting clubs involved around Australia, reaching an estimated 1.5 million people.

For over 12 years Good Sports has supported sporting clubs to reduce alcohol and tobaccorelated harms within the club and the wider community. It also now addresses nutrition and mental health through its Good Sports Healthy Eating and Good Sports Healthy Minds programs.

Through Good Sports, clubs work through three levels of accreditation that identify a range of areas in which they can improve practices including alcohol and tobacco management, safe transport and alternative fundraising strategies.
