We are excited to confirm that the Batemans Bay Paddle Challenge is back for 2018 and entries are now open for the event to be held on 28 April 2018.

There will be 3 race distances, with 26 categories for competitive paddlers including K1s, K2s/doubles, Surf Skis, Ocean Skis, OC1s, OC2s and SUP for both males and females.

The main event is a monster 26km marathon race between the Batemans Bay and Nelligen bridges and return, with a cash and prize pool for the top two in each of the male and female categories in the main events.
