Thank you to our whole community for the Tathra bushfire response

Our friends and neighbours in Tathra experienced a devastating fire on 18th March. In a sure sign of a remarkable community the people of Tathra have faced the bushfires and the aftermath with incredible spirit, mateship and a determination to rebuild their beautiful town.

A couple of us had the opportunity to visit the Tathra Surf Club last weekend and the town is most definitely open for business. One way we can all support the town is to visit and spend some dollars there. Encourage your friends and family to visit too.

We also want to extend a heartfelt thank you to everyone in Bermagui and area who stepped up to lend a hand at the evacuation centre.

Bermagui Surf Club was asked to open as an evacuation centre once the road from Tathra to Bega was cutoff and the Bermagui-Tathra Road became the only way out of town for many.

We're not a designated evacuation centre so didn't have a plan in place but our team jumped in and pulled it together on the fly.

As the news spread that evacuees were arriving at the Surf Club the donations and helping hands from right across the community started to pour in. By the end of the evening we'd registered 320 evacuees and had offers of accommodation from locals willing to house far more than that. We also received donated bedding, clothes, toys and more. The generosity was outstanding.

There are too many people to thank but we wanted to make special mention of the following for their help over the 3 days: Woolworths, Mark Manning, Bermagui Country Club, Neil Rutherford, Andrew Curven, Rachel Wallbank, Rowan Blake, Steve O'Sullivan, Shelley Davis, Fran Trenerry and Tanya Neilson.

NSW Police and NSW Ambulance were also amazing to deal with, thanks so much to everyone for pitching in and helping to ease what was such a stressful and difficult time for so many.

We were truly humbled by the response - love this town!

A shout out also to the Tathra SLSC and Pambula SLSC call out crews who worked late into the night on the 18th to provide a water evacuation route on the Bega River outstanding work by all.
