## Who are we:

We are a registered charity of qualified teachers from the United Kingdom providing emergency education and support to children currently in refugee camps.

Edlumino Education Aid is a collaboration of qualified teachers and education experts from the UK and mainland Europe who are united in actioning their belief that education is for all children, irrespective of their current circumstances.

#### **We teach:**

Children aged 7-17 in core subjects and qualifications.



#### **We've setup:**

To date four separate studios teaching over 500 refugee children



#### **We are educators:**

We focus solely on teaching children and their welfare. We do not lobby parliament or take part in political campaigns.

Under the leadership of Dr Rory Fox, an experienced executive headteacher with over 25 years educational experience, teams of teachers are recruited so that students in refugee camps are able to access education delivered to International Standards.

Our curriculum centres are called 'Studiums.' They run every weekday providing between 10 and 15 hours a week of education for up to 300 children.

Edlumino Education Aid is committed to working with local and national stakeholders to enhance the provision of education for students in the camp. As a non-political organisation we work solely for the children in the camp, securing their future with others. Ultimately we want the children in the camp school ready, and disrupted as little as possible from being away from traditional schooling for a period of time with qualifications where possible.



We teach the children mainly in English with language assistants to help the children in their first language. We actively support members of the refugee and local community working with us in this way. Children learn to read, write and speak in English alongside developing their skills in their first language.

In Maths children catch up and learn mathematical skills in line with the expectations in International countries which achieve above average PISA scores.

Children aged 15+ can be entered for international exams to achieve recognised qualifications to support their future success.
