COSTUME FEES

Our 2019 Production: The Making of a Super HERO will be a spectacular display of talent by our students, and the work starts now!

All costume fees for dancers who are participating in the recital are due no later than Wednesday October 31st. If the costume fees are not paid in full the student will be able to continue in the class, they will not, however, participate in the production. If you know that your dancer is not participating in the show, please stop by the desk so we can remove the fees.

All costume fees must be paid in person at the front desk using cash or check. We also have a Cash App, but to ensure that the account is credited to your account correctly, Cash App must be used in person.

Reminder: \$3.00 per kit sold with our Little Caesar's Fundraiser will also be applied to your costume balance. Orders are due 10/20/18.

ADULT CLASSES

We heard your requests, and we have answered! MCDF Now offers a wide array of dance and fitness classes for adults. The commitment level is up to you! You can select to Drop In a class for a one time fee of \$10.00 or you may purchase a Punch Card (\$35, \$60, \$75). We offer Ballet, Tap, Hip Hop, Ballroom, Jit, African, Liturgical, Kickboxing, Hip Hop Sculpt, and Advanced Jazz for experienced adults.

ATTENDANCE

Please note that punctuality and attendance are very important. Students should arrive to class at least 5 minutes early and be ready to participate at their scheduled time. For their safety, students who arrive 10 minutes or more late for gymnastics or dance will not be allowed to enter class once the warm-up is completed. Many of our classes are full, and excessive absences / tardiness may result in removal to allow a student from our waiting list to enroll.



LATENESS the 10 minute rule

If you are more than 10 minutes late please do not enter the class. By missing the warm-up students may be at risk of injury.
